AHEPA Seacoast Scholarship Application Process



Scholarships

Each year, AHEPA 215 may award scholarships to worthy high school seniors. The dollar amount of the scholarship awards may vary each year subject to the availability of funds.

Applicant Eligibility requirements:

1. Is a graduating high school senior within AHEPA 215 area high schools listed below:
 - Dover High School
 - Oyster River High School
 - Portsmouth High School
 - Robert W. Traip Academy
 - Winnacunnet High School
 - York High School
2. The applicant must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.25 or must be ranked in the upper 25% of the class.

Online Application Process:

2. Education Objective Essay - in 250 words or less provide a brief statement of your educational objectives. Include in your statement what you plan to study and what you hope to achieve through your study.
3. Community Service Essay - in 500 words or less, describe the community service that you performed and how did your activities have a positive impact on the community? and how did it affect you?
4. Before starting your application it is recommended that you review the full application.
5. Application deadline is **April 30, 2021 at midnight.**

Applications not meeting all of the above criteria will be disqualified by the scholarship committee.

The selection of the scholarship recipients will be made solely by the AHEPA 215 Scholarship Committee. All information on the scholarship applications shall be confidential and shall be respected and recognized as such by the AHEPA 215 Scholarship Committee.

All applicants will be notified in writing of the decision by the Scholarship Committee. All decisions made by the committee will be final based upon the information that was submitted by the applicant.
